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**Nominations for Idaho Human Rights Leadership Scholarship Award  
Accepted Through Friday, December 17, 2010**

Current college junior or senior credit standing or graduate students have until December 17, 2010, to apply for the Idaho Human Rights Leadership Scholarship Award. The \$2,000 scholarship is awarded to a college student who has demonstrated knowledge, understanding and commitment to diversity and inclusion through their course of study and community involvement in human rights or inclusiveness issues beyond her/his college or university. Applicants are required to be at least 18-years, with a current grade point average of or greater than 3.0. Applications should be sent to the Idaho Inclusiveness Coalition, [scholarship@idahoincludes.org](mailto:scholarship@idahoincludes.org) and received by December 17, 2010 deadline.

Applicants are also required to submit three letters of recommendation attesting to the applicant's leadership role in human rights or inclusiveness issues, along with a one-page essay explaining their experience and commitment to the principles of diversity. The Idaho Human Rights Leadership Scholarship Award is a biennial recognition presented by the Idaho Inclusiveness Coalition (IIC).
